Admissions Application Packet

Enrollment requirements

To participate in either of the Thai Massage Professional Programs students must be:

- 18 year of age or older
- Proficient in speaking, reading, and writing in English
- Vaccinated against SARS-CoV-2
- Citizens or legal residents of the United States or its territories

Students also must have physical, mental, emotional, language and technical capacity needed for successful completion of program and entry into the massage profession.

Ability Considerations

Physical: Thai bodywork is a physical modality that requires an ability to kneel and squat. Students with physical ability differences or challenges, concerns about their ability to to engage in the program, or who anticipate being pregnant for any part of the program, should make sure to discuss these considerations in their admission interview in order to best make sure that they can participate safely and successfully and their instructors are prepared to meet their needs.

Cognitive/Mental/Emotional: Students with severe test anxiety, reading & comprehension challenges, or mental/emotional considerations are encouraged to discuss this in their admission interview in order to best make sure that they can participate safely and successfully and their instructors are prepared to meet their needs.

Language: English language proficiency must be very strong as students will be studying medical/anatomical terminology. Please discuss any fluency concerns during your admissions interview.

Computer/Technology Literacy: This program utilizes a variety of technological platforms including website based resources, Zoom, and phone messaging apps. Students who need extra assistance in familiarizing themselves with these systems will be given significant guidance and support.

Enrollment checklist

- □ Receive at least one professional Thai massage within the last year.
- □ Submit completed program application package including:
 - □ Application form
 - Copy of photo ID front and back (driver's license, passport, or other government issued ID)
 - □ Proof of up to date complete SARS-CoV-2 (COVID-19) series
 - □ Provide three professional/education references
 - □ Application essay
- □ Complete admission interview (you will be contacted to schedule upon receipt of application)
- □ Receive acceptance or contingent acceptance letter
- □ Show proof of student liability insurance (see below)
- □ Pay \$50 registration fee and any other associated fees and deposits
- □ Completion of signed enrollment agreement (*provided after admissions interview*)
- □ Payment in full, or payment for first semester, or first monthly payment depending on payment plan optioned.
- □ Acquisition of all books and other materials needed at start of program (*book and materials list will be provided upon acceptance*)

Acceptance and Deadlines

Potential students are accepted based on a variety of factors including timing (space is limited and most likely will fill), fulfilling all requirements, and demonstration through essay, interview and references of likelihood of ability to successfully complete the program. There is no application deadline ahead of start of classes, however the sooner potential students apply the greater the chance of getting into the program. If there is space in the program applications will be accepted up to two weeks past the first day of classes with factors such as the student's ability to make up missed work taken into account in the decision making process. Students will be contacted within one week of receipt of application packet to schedule an admissions interview.

Evaluation Criteria

Evaluation of student ability to successfully navigate and complete the program and enter into a professional massage career is established through evaluating admissions application, admissions essay, references, and interview for:

• Language proficiency - students must have English fluency demonstrative of an ability to learn medical terminology, read academic health science texts, and communicate with future massage clientele.

- Community support system students have a stronger potential for successful completion of program if they have supportive family, partnerships, friends although this a conversation not a hard line.
- Life responsibilities/time commitments *Students need to be able to set aside a significant portion of time to attend classes and complete homework assignments.*
- Ability Discussion of any physical, psychological, or cognitive conditions that may impact student ability to successfully complete the program and state exam requirements for licensure.
- Self reflection showing reasoned motivation for joining program
- Foundational understanding of what Thai massage is *Students who do not possess this will be educated during their admissions interview such that they can assess their desire to dedicate their studies to this modality.*

Non-Discrimination Policy ~ Equity

The Naga Center does not discriminate based on race, ethnicity, gender identity or presentation, sexual orientation, religion, national origin, status, political affiliations or any other such nonsense nor do we allow for such discrimination to rear its sad head in our classrooms. Student Liability Insurance

All students must have student liability insurance purchased through Massage Magazine Insurance Plus (MMIP)² at <u>https://www.massageliabilityinsurancegroup.com/student/</u> and must show proof of insurance as part of their application package.

The cost is approximately \$40 per year.
